What is it?

The Patriot Green Fund (PGF) is a \$100,000 annual sustainability fund provided by Mason Facilities and managed by the Office of Sustainability that is dedicated to making Mason's campuses more sustainable through infrastructure improvements and student research projects.

Who is eligible?

Mason students, staff, and faculty are eligible to apply for funds to support infrastructure projects and student sustainability research projects. For students, completed projects are eligible for a <u>Mason Impact</u> designation on their transcripts.

How do I apply?

Is it a short, small-scale project that will cost less than \$1,000?

Apply using a Quick Fund Application

Quick Funds are reviewed by the PGF Committee on a rolling basis and are designed to assist with semester-long infrastructure projects or sustainability research projects.

Is it a large-scale project that will cost more than \$1,000?

Apply using the Preliminary and Final Applications for Infrastructure and Research Projects

Part 1: Submit a Preliminary Application to the PGF Committee for review and feedback.

Part 2: Once the Preliminary Application is approved and feedback is incorporated, a Final Application must be submitted to the PGF Committee.

Preliminary and Final Applications must be submitted by the posted deadlines.
