2	Has the applicant considered and identified departments, programs, faculty, staff, etc. that might be involved with their project? Are any approvals granted?			
3	In the case of a student applicant, is there faculty involvement?			
4	Does this applicant demonstrate knowledge and commitment to their project?			
5	Is this project feasible in the time frame and budget proposed?			
6	Will this project reduce Mason's environmental impact by making direct improvements to habits, facilities and operations?			
7	Will this increase sustainability on campus, Mason's surrounding communities, or the Metro D.C. region (if research)?			
8	Does it build community around sustainability on campus?			
9	Does this project meet the PGF learning outcomes?			
10	Is this project repeatable? Can it continue in the future, or will it end after the applicant leaves the Mason community?			
11	Does the applicant have a public outreach plan? Is the project itself very visible?
